Our services include scripture readings and relevant, upbeat sermons that connect the Bible with our everyday lives. Holy Communion is celebrated every Sunday. ALL baptized Christians are invited and welcome to our table.

Sundays - 8:00 AM

This worship service seeks to be a little more 'quiet' in character. We sing a little less than at our 10:00 am service. At 8:00 AM, we are seeking to build in a little bit of silence into our prayer. It's a regular Sunday celebration in all other respects - filled with life and joy. We proclaim all of the Sunday readings, have a celebration of Holy Communion, and are sent forth to love and serve the Lord and one another.

Sundays - 10:00 AM

We celebrate, sing, share communion and are occasionally treated to an anthem by our choir or an instrumental meditation by a parish member. Under the guidance of our musician, Carrie, parish members are cantors for the psalm. During this service, Worship Center meets as does the Children's Liturgy of the Word.

Centering Prayer - Monday at 5:30 PM.
