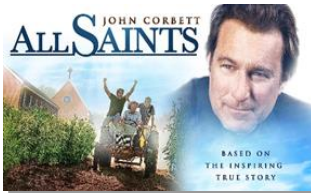

This workshop is meant as a follow-up to the sessions offered in April 2023. It will be led by Kingswood Consulting from Minneapolis. Fr. Tim Kingsley, one

of the presenters and co-founder of Kingswood, is a priest in the Episcopal Diocese of Minnesota. He has an extensive history in security and safety.

Then in **April** we would have a special joint diocesan convention to vote on the joint agreement of union.

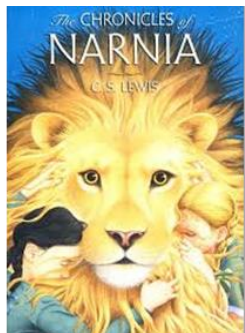
