## **TRANSITION & TIMELINES**

 Phase I—Initial Diocesan Information Sharing/Meet with Canon to understand transition process: Focus on saying goodbye, establish Discernment Committee, supply clergy found for all worship services, emergency pastoral care defined. COMPLETE

- 2. Phase II—Discovery Phase: Focus Groups meet to get a better understanding of the ministry needs of our congregation. The Office of Transitional Ministries is responsible for obtaining names of discerning priests of which Peggy Bean, our Canon for Congregations is currently searching and obtaining names. The Discernment Committee will look at our focus group feedback comments to determine who we are as a parish community and what we are looking for in a new Rector. IN PROCESS
- 3. **Phase III—Interviews**: The Discernment Committee prepares for phone interviews, putting together interview questions based on the discovery phase; and coordinating interview logistics. They will also review portfolios and resumes, read blogs, & hear sermons. They will then phone interview candidates.
- 4. Phase IV—Congregational Visits to Discerning Priests' Parishes
- 5. Phase V—Visit by Discerning Priests
