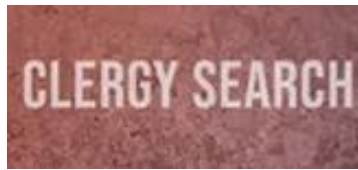
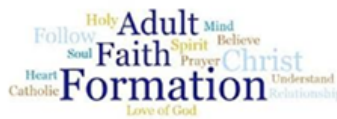


ST. MARY'S ANNOUNCEMENTS
