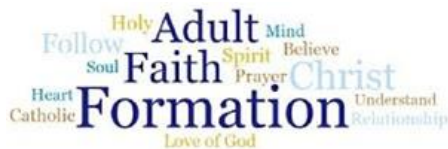
FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENT HOST FAMILIES
