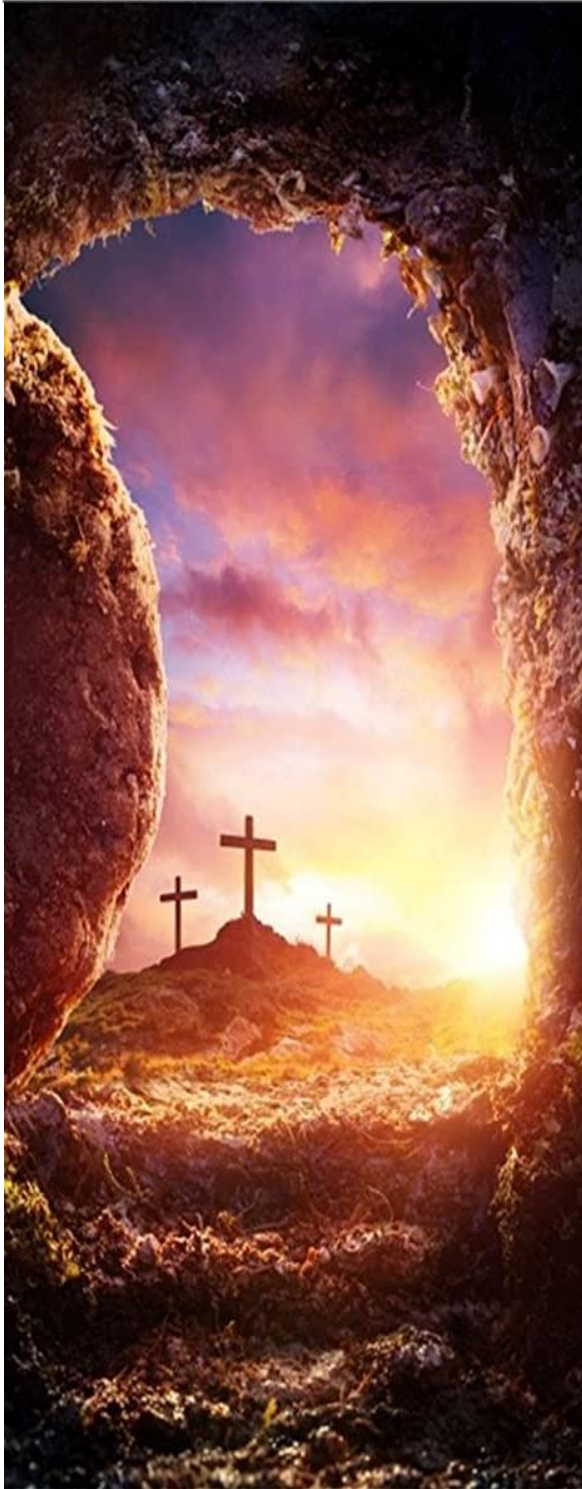

A MESSAGE FROM MOTHER PIPPA



Dear St. Mary's Parish,

Last Saturday was the Dousman Chamber of Commerce Member Dinner. Jane Pennycuff, Kim Smith, Craig Beckman, Diane Olsen, Carol Schmitt, Lynn Kallas and I were there to represent St. Mary's and meet with other community leaders. Our theme was a 1920's murder mystery, and as it turns out, the murderer was our own Diane Olsen, playing the mother of the bride. However, she put on such a convincing façade of innocence that she got away with the crime. Dousman has a fairly active Chamber of Commerce, and we participate in their events throughout the year. I check IDs for the Beer Gardens (June 17 and September 23 this year), St. Mary's participates in the Dousman Rummage Sale (August 26) and I help plan Winterfest (December 3), where St. Mary's competes in the Chili Competition. I am hoping we will participate in this year's Derby Days Parade on July 30, and the circus is coming to town in August! If you are interested in volunteering at an event this year, please let me know. It's a lot of fun, and also a wonderful way to become more connected to the Dousman community.

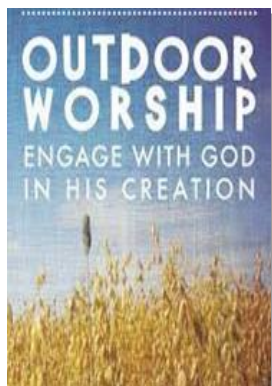

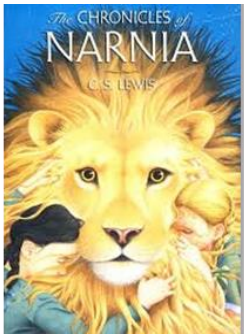

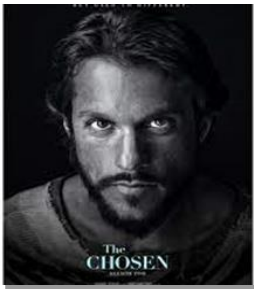
