Dear St. Mary's Parish,

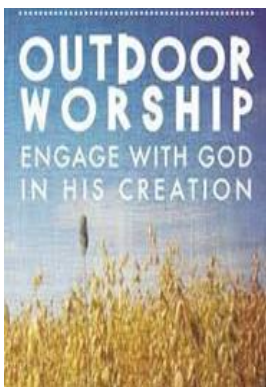

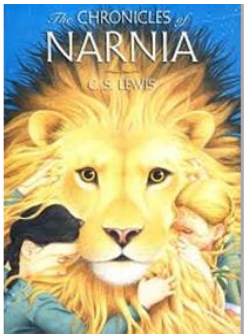

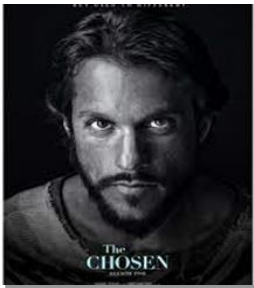
