COFFEE HOUR HOSTS

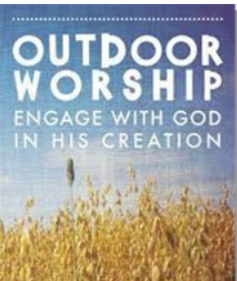
